

Curriculum Coverage Overview – Autumn Term 1 2023/2024

English

Text: Katie in London: This storybook introduces young readers to Katie and her journey around London in a fun and illustrious way. The children will explore, interpret and respond to events in the narrative. They will also write for different purposes and eventually sequence events to write a short narrative.

Text: Rosie Revere, Engineer: This is a charming and witty picture book about pursuing your passion. This wonderful story will lead the young writers to construct short explanations, report writing and finally create an advert.

Poetry: The children will explore features of acrostic poems and create their own acrostic poem linked to the topic they are learning about - London.

Science: Living things and plants

This unit allows students to distinguish between living and nonliving things; exploring the basic needs of living things, focusing on plants and their habitats. The children will be introduced to experimental methods, make observations, record results, and draw conclusions.

Geography: Let's explore London

This great Geography scheme of work will help Year 2 to find out more about London, including its location, geographical features and famous landmarks.

PE: Landscape and Cityscapes

In PE, the children will learn to roll in different ways including being introduced to the skill of a crouched forward roll. They will learn to jump from a springboard and begin to do a handstand. The children will develop body tension, control and balance as well as moving with greater agility and coordination.

PE Day: Friday

Year 2

Art: Landscapes and Cityscapes

This term in Art, Year 2 will learn about the bright colours and bold brushstrokes used by the impressionists, and other artists, when painting landscapes and cityscapes. They will be introduced to the work of Claude Monet, Vincent van Gogh, and Jean Metzinger.



Y2 Arabic

In Arabic this term, the children will learn:

- Greetings; saying 'My name is...'
- Names of colours
- Demonstrative Pronouns; This مذه
- Nouns associated with people: e.g. boy, girl....
- Family members

IPSHE: Family

This term, the children will learn to recognise who the special people around them are and what makes them special. We will go on to discuss communities and differences in people who are around us.

Maths

This term, Year 2 will focus on:

- Counting objects to 100, reading and writing numbers in numerals and words.
- Recognising the place value of each digit in 2-digit numbers.
- Identifying, representing and estimating numbers using different representations.
- Comparing and ordering numbers using the < ,>, = signs
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 3s.
- Recalling and using addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently.
- Deriving and using related facts up to 100.

Islamic Studies: Fiqh

This term, we will be covering the topic of Fiqh. We will be distinguishing the three different times when to use water to attain taharah, listing the number of Faraidh, Sunan, Makruhat and Nawaqid in Wudu, summarising what Tayammum is and when it is used, and demonstrating the full method of performing salaah.

Hadeeth: Speaking the truth.

Surah and Duaa Memorisation:

Review surahs and duaas from Year 1. Surah Quraysh, Surah Fil, 4th Kalimah, 5th Kalimah, Takbir Tahrimah, Duaa Al Istiftah and Thana

Qaaidah:

To practise recitation of the Qaaidah/Juz Amma/Quraan.

ICT: Online safety

The children will learn how to improve the efficiency of their online searches, the types of websites that are best for children to access when looking for information, as well as how to identify inappropriate content and the actions they should take if they do.
